Training sessions provide a practical introduction to sensory integration through the lens of developmental trauma. They aim to help professionals understand how sensory processing can influence children's regulation, behaviour, learning and everyday participation.

Training can be commissioned by local authorities, education settings, social care teams and partner organisations, and tailored to the needs of your service and the children you support. Participants will explore key sensory systems, trauma-informed practice and practical adaptations to environments, routines and activities, helping children feel safer, more regulated and better able to engage.

Example topics include:

- Recognising Body Cues and Supporting Emotional Regulation
- Sensory Integration in the Context of Developmental Trauma
- Developing Sensory Ladders and Regulation Toolkits
- Designing Sensory-Friendly Learning Environments
